

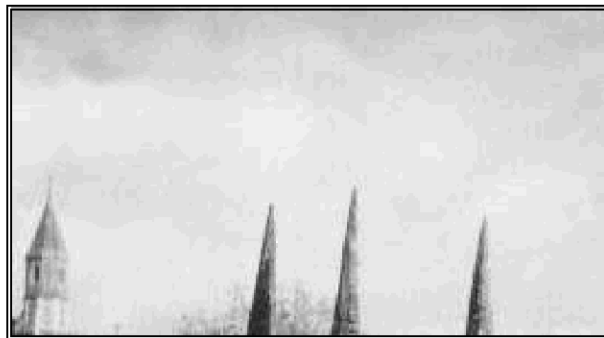
A Poetic Conundrum – the answer
